



1.0 Requirements

- 1.1 The Seller shall provide a shelf-life label (preferred method) or a shelf life certificate with the shipment. The label / certificate shall include:
 - 1.1.1 Manufacturer's name
 - 1.1.2 Manufacturer's compound/batch/lot number (as applicable)
 - 1.1.3 Manufactured, cure, and/or shelf life start date as applicable
 - 1.1.4 Suggested expiration date
 - 1.3.1.1 The suggested expiration date format shall be MM/DD/YYYY or YYYY/MM/DD.
 - 1.1.5 Specification to which the item is purchased, with type and class (if applicable)
 - 1.1.6 Tampa Brass & Aluminum Corp. part number (if applicable)
 - 1.1.7 Storage temperature (if applicable)
 - 1.1.8 If the material is temperature sensitive, storage requirements must be labeled on the exterior surface of each package shipped.
- 1.2 The seller shall provide material with at least 25% of the specified shelf-life remaining. Seller shall not ship material that cannot meet this requirement without prior written approval from Tampa Brass & Aluminum Corp.

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
